Your Child

Your child will receive care and education that:

- stimulates their social, physical, emotional, cognitive, language and creative potential
- is appropriate to their individual interests, needs and development level
- · promotes identity, wellbeing and confidence
- · connects them to their community

Your child will be:

- · encouraged to express themselves
- · encouraged to participate in activities
- · treated respectfully and with dignity
- · treated without bias
- given the opportunity to become self reliant
- · given positive behavioural guidance
- given support in their learning experiences
- · given emotional support

Your child will not be:

- exposed to physical, verbal or emotional punishment that humiliates, frightens or threatens your child
- separated from other children for any reason other than illness or accident
- required to undertake any activities that are inappropriate for their age, physical and intellectual development
- · required to sleep or rest against their wishes
- administered any medication without your authorisation except in case of emergency

Your child will have access to:

- · safe drinking water at all times
- sufficient nutritious food and beverages that accounts for dietary, cultural and religious considerations (Noogaleek only)

Our Service

You can expect our service environment to:

- be positive & adaptable to your child's needs
- · be clean, well maintained and child safe
- · be free from tobacco, drugs and alcohol
- have indoor & outdoor space, facilities and resources that are safe and sufficient to meet your child's care and educational needs
- have appropriate safety equipment available
- · have safe and adequate fencing
- provide protection from the sun and weather

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- complain about our service, staff or standards without fear of denial of service
- have complaints investigated fairly and confidentially, and to have appropriate steps taken to resolve issues of concern
- access your child's enrolment, attendance, medication, medical and assessment records
- · access staff qualifications & training records
- attend our service at any time that your child is in our care

Your Right to information

You will be notified of any:

- illness, injury, trauma or other serious incident that affects your child
- · infectious diseases at our service
- service closures or interruptions
- · changes to fees charged
- · fees charged, paid and outstanding
- · pending removal of allocated days

You will be given information on:

- · our assessment of your child's progress
- how to make comments & complaints about the care & education that your child receives
- how we will manage any specific medical issue affecting your child

Our Staff

You can expect our staff to be:

- qualified as per Childcare regulations
- trained in providing care, education and first aid to your child
- trained in procedures for emergencies, evacuation and other serious incidents
- diligent and proactive when supervising children and monitoring their activities

You can expect our staff to:

- interact with your child in a positive, caring and respectful manner
- monitor and act on any safety concerns that could impact on your child
- promote and observe safe hygiene practices
- respect your privacy and confidentiality
- · follow child care regulations
