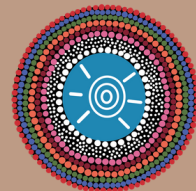
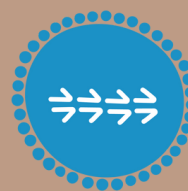

and Kirra- Homelessness support with Going Home Staying Home.

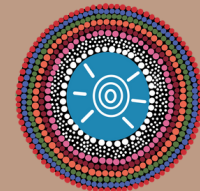
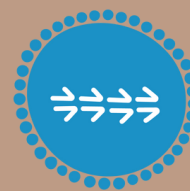


Batemans Bay Office Opening

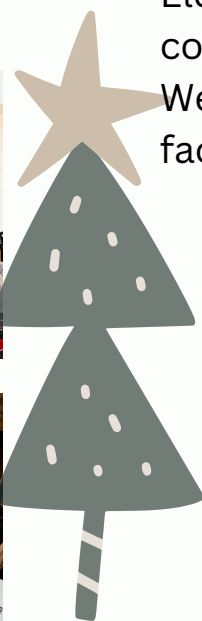


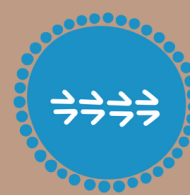
Elders Social group

Looking Ahead to 2026

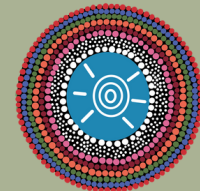
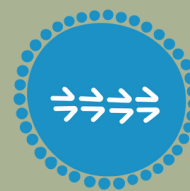
We're excited to share that IAC will have a full calendar of cultural programs planned for 2026, including:

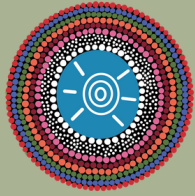
Elders community Christmas lunch
